1. The theological virtues are **faith, hope and charity** (love).
2. The cardinal virtues are **prudence, temperance (moderation), justice and fortitude (courage)**.
3. The four cardinal virtues are called "cardinal" because the Latin word "cardo" means "hinge," and these virtues are considered **the foundation upon which all other virtues hinge or depend**. They are seen as fundamental to a virtuous life, serving as the basis for all other moral behavior.
4. **Fortitude**, also called courage.
5. St. Paul says that **love (charity)** is the greatest virtue of all (1 Cor 13).
