1. St. Paul experienced his conversion on the “road to Damascus” according to the Acts of the Apostles.
2. St. Paul is often referred to as the Apostle to the Gentiles.
3. It is called the “Basilica of St. Paul outside the walls,” meaning outside the walls of the ancient city of Rome.
4. In John 21:15-19, Jesus asks Peter three times “Do you love me?” These may correspond to the three times Peter denied that he even knew Jesus.
5. Yes, Saint Peter eventually came to approve of preaching the gospel to Gentiles. While initially hesitant, Peter had a vision that led him to believe God intended the gospel for all people, not just Jews. This vision and subsequent events resulted in him preaching to the Gentiles and declaring that God shows no favoritism.
