

Catholic Trivia 12-23 Answers:

1. Only the gospels of **Matthew** and **Luke** tell us about the events surrounding the birth of Jesus.
2. Epiphany means “**manifestation or showing forth.**”
3. The Holy Innocents are the young children in Bethlehem killed by King Herod the Great in his attempt to kill the infant Jesus (Matthew 2:16–18). Their feast day is December 28.
4. Although we sing of “we three kings,” the Bible makes no mention of how many Magi made the journey. We are only told that they came from the East and brought gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.
5. Jesus was born in Bethlehem, brought up in Nazareth and preached in Jerusalem but it was the significant Galilean Ministry years which he spent in **Capernaum** and where he performed many of his miracles. **Capernaum** became his home and the Bible calls it **Jesus'** “own city”. (Matthew 9:1)
