1. The feast was formerly called Corpus Christi.
2. In addition to the synoptic gospels (Matthew, Mark, and Luke), the words of institution are also recorded by St. Paul in 1 Corinthians.
3. The two primary parts of the Mass are the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist.
4. Although our biblical accounts of the Last Supper are written in Greek, the ordinary language of Jesus was Aramaic.
5. In the Catholic Church, unleavened bread is used for Mass because Jesus instituted the Eucharist at the Last Supper, which was a Jewish Passover meal. According to Scripture, Passover strictly required the use of unleavened bread, symbolizing both the haste of the Exodus and spiritual purity.
