

Catholic Trivia 5-6 Answers:

1. The three orders are: **diaconate** (deacons), **presbyterate** (priests), and **episcopate** (bishops).
2. Only a bishop may ordain a deacon, priest or bishop.
3. In addition to Holy Orders, we have: **Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Penance/Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick, and Matrimony.**
4. The three vows that most religious men and women take are **poverty, chastity** and **obedience**. Some congregations have a fourth or even fifth vow (e.g., Little Sisters of the Poor take a vow of hospitality to the poor).
5. As defined in canon 731 §1: “Societies of apostolic life resemble institutes of consecrated life; their members, **without religious vows**, pursue the apostolic purpose proper to the society and, leading a life in common as brothers or sisters according to their proper manner of life, strive for the perfection of charity through the observance of the constitutions.” **The Eudists (Congregation of Jesus and Mary) are a Society of Apostolic Life**, not a religious order, and therefore do not take the three traditional vows.
