

## Catholic Trivia Answers 5/26

1. The **Solemnity of Pentecost** celebrates the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples and as a gift to the Church.
2. The Holy Spirit is also called the Paraclete, the Advocate, the Spirit of Truth, the Spirit of God, the Consoler, the Spirit of Love and (in former times) the Holy Ghost.
3. The description of the Holy Spirit coming upon the disciples on the Jewish feast of Pentecost is found in the **Acts of the Apostles 2:1-11**.
4. A strong driving **wind** and tongues of **fire** above the heads of each disciple.
5. The Holy Spirit proceeds **from the Father and the Son**. The Holy Spirit does not proceed from the Father and the Son by spiritual generation. Only the Son proceeds from the Father by generation. This is one of the mysterious truths that we know only from revelation.
