2. **Pope John Paul I** (Alberto Luciani) was head of the Catholic Church and Bishop of Rome from 26 August 1978 until his death 33 days later. He was the first pope to have been born in the 20th century.
3. The **Diocese of San Diego** is under the leadership of Bishop Robert McElroy. An archdiocese is a diocese with greater size or historical significance than a typical diocese. The bishop of an archdiocese is called an archbishop. A suffragan bishop is the bishop of a diocese under the metropolitan in the province, called a suffrage diocese. San Diego is a suffragan diocese of the archdiocese of Los Angeles.
