

Catholic Trivia 11-25 Answers:

1. The correct answer is: **it depends**. Unlike Lent, Advent does not have a fixed number of days. It depends on what day December 25 falls. Its length varies from 22 to 28 days.
2. The Third Sunday of Advent is often called **Gaudete Sunday** because the entrance antiphon of the Mass for that day begins with Rejoice! (Gaudete)
3. According to the US bishops' website, **the Christmas season concludes on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord**.
4. The messenger of the Annunciation was the **Angel Gabriel**.
5. Since it is widely believed that the Gospel of Luke and the **Acts of the Apostles** are written by the same author, Acts can be referred to as volume 2.
