

## **Catholic Trivia 5-22 Answers**

1. The first non-Italian pope since 1523 was **Pope John Paul II**. He was born Karol Jozef Wojtyla on May 20, 1920 in Poland. He served as pope from October 16, 1978 until April 2, 2005.
2. Catholics are asked to **fast for one hour** prior to receiving Holy Communion.
3. In 2018, Pope Francis decreed that the memorial of the **Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church** be inserted into the Roman Calendar on the Monday after Pentecost.
4. It is an abbreviation for **Jesus**. IHS are the first three letters of the name Jesus in Greek.
5. The **Congregation of Jesus and Mary (CJM)** was founded by St. John Eudes in 1643. More commonly it is referred to as the Eudists or Eudist Fathers.
