

### **Catholic Trivia 9-17 Answers:**

1. They referred to the Eucharist as **“the breaking of the bread.”**
2. It is found in the **Gospel of John, chapter 6.**
3. The institution of the Eucharist is also recorded in **1 Corinthians 11:23-25**
4. The answer is that it is not safe to share a common cup during the health crisis of the Covid-19 pandemic.
5. The Council of Constance (1414-1418) raised to the level of dogma the point that Christ is fully present under each species. The Council of Trent reaffirmed this teaching in the 16th century. The simplest explanation is that Christ himself is not divided between the bread and wine. So, those who receive the consecrated host receive the full Christ. Likewise, those who receive only from the chalice receive the full Christ.
