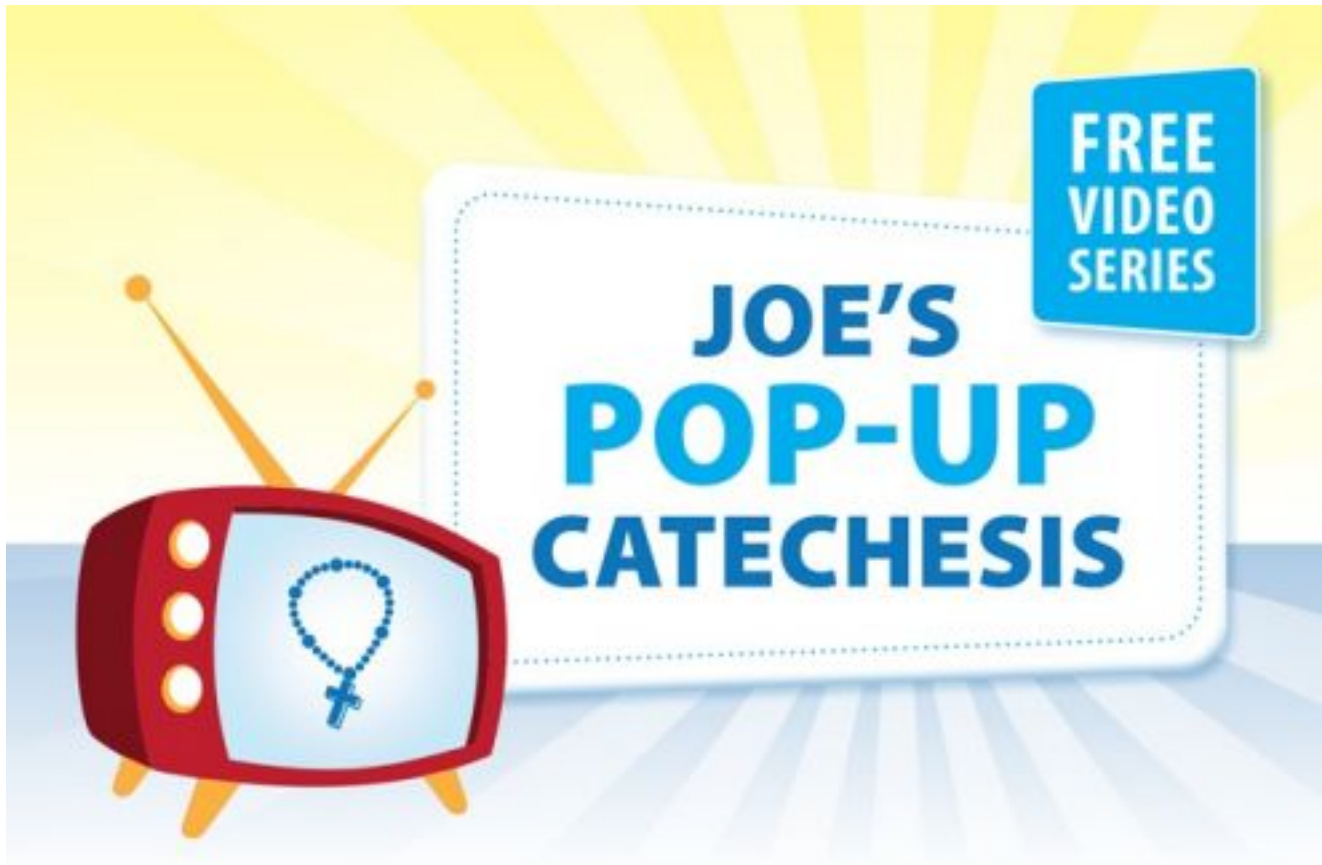


# Pop-Up Catechesis: November, the Month of All Souls
