

Catholic Trivia 3-19 Answers:

1. March 19 is the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Husband of Mary. However, May 1 is the feast of St. Joseph the Worker.
2. Matthew 1: 18-25
3. Joseph is never mentioned in the Gospel of Mark. He is only mentioned once in the Gospel of John when someone refers to Jesus as “son of Joseph.”
4. Joseph doesn’t get even one quote in the Scriptures. Rather, he is a silent, humble servant of God who does his task well, and no more.
5. Veneration of him goes back at least to the 9th century. An early title used to honor him was *nutritor Domini*, meaning “guardian of the Lord.”
