

Catholic Trivia 4-11-25 Answers:

1. Golgotha is “the place of the skull.”
2. Pontius Pilate was the procurator.
3. In Mark's Gospel, women followers of Jesus, including Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome, are mentioned as being present at the cross, while the disciples are said to have deserted Jesus and fled.
4. The gospel of John tells us that the Beloved Disciple was at the cross along with the Mother of Jesus (without ever mentioning their names).
5. The inscription on the cross, “Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews,” was written in Hebrew, Latin, and Greek, according to John 19:20.
