

Catholic Trivia 2-26 Answers:

1. The temptation of Christ is a biblical narrative included in the gospels of **Matthew, Mark and Luke**. After being baptized by John the Baptist, Jesus was tempted by the devil for 40 days and nights in the Judean Desert. This event is not included in the gospel of John.
2. The description of the Transfiguration of Jesus is recorded in the gospels of **Matthew, Mark and Luke** (with slight variations). There is not a description of the Transfiguration in the gospel of John.
3. In the second letter of **Peter 1:11-16**, we read: For we did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we had been eyewitnesses of his majesty. For he received honor and glory from God the Father when that voice was conveyed to him by the Majestic Glory, saying, "This is my Son, my Beloved, with whom I am well pleased." We ourselves heard this voice come from heaven, while we were with him on the holy mountain.
4. While the Last Supper of Jesus with his disciples is mentioned in all four gospels, the Institution of the Eucharist is mentioned only in **Matthew, Mark and Luke**. In the gospel of John, at the Last Supper Jesus washes the feet of his disciples, gives a lengthy instruction and offers a special prayer for them.
5. While the Eucharist is mentioned in several places in the New Testament, the most direct reference to the institution of the Eucharist at the Last supper is in **1 Corinthians 11:23-26**.
