1. The **alb** which comes from the word for “white.”
2. The **stole**, which is worn for all official liturgical events and comes in all the liturgical colors.
3. The **chasuble**. Its color changes with the liturgical season or feast.
4. The **dalmatic** which worn exclusively by the deacon and comes in all the liturgical colors
5. The basic liturgical colors are white, green, purple, red, rose and gold.

Color	Meaning	Used For
White	Joy, purity, resurrection	Christmas, Easter, feasts of the Lord (except Passion), Mary, angels, non-martyr saints, weddings, baptisms
Red	Holy Spirit, sacrifice, martyrdom	Pentecost, Palm Sunday, Good Friday, feasts of Apostles, Evangelists, Martyrs
Green	Hope, life, growth	Ordinary Time
Violet (Purple)	Penance, preparation	Advent, Lent, penitential liturgies
Rose	Joy in the midst of penance	Gaudete Sunday, Laetare Sunday
Gold	Solemnity, festivity	May replace white, red, or green on major feasts and solemn celebrations
