

Catholic Trivia 10-16 Answers:

1. **John F. Kennedy** – 35th President of the United States
2. Vatican II began on October 11, 1962 and ended December 8, 1965 (although the bishops were together for the months of autumn in each of those years).
3. According to the 2020 Pontifical Yearbook (*Annuario Pontificio*) there are **1.329 billion** Catholics in the world.
4. As of September 29, 2020, there are **219** cardinals in the world, 120 of whom are cardinal electors (under 80 years old and thereby able to vote in a papal conclave).
5. There have been **three** non-Italian popes in the last 100 years: **John Paul II** (1978-2005) who was from Poland; **Benedict XVI** (2005-2013) who was from Germany; and **Pope Francis** (2005-present) who is from Argentina.
