- 1. **John F. Kennedy** 35<sup>th</sup> President of the United States
- 2. Vatican II began on October 11, 1962 and ended December 8, 1965 (although the bishops were together for the months of autumn in each of those years).
- 3. According to the 2020 Pontifical Yearbook (*Annuario Pontificio*) there are **1.329 billion** Catholics in the world.
- 4. As of September 29, 2020, there are **219** cardinals in the world, 120 of whom are cardinal electors (under 80 years old and thereby able to vote in a papal conclave).
- 5. There have been **three** non-Italian popes in the last 100 years: **John Paul II** (1978-2005) who was from Poland; **Benedict XVI** (2005-2013) who was from Germany; and **Pope Francis** (2005-present) who is from Argentina.
