

Catholic Trivia 3-13-26 Answers:

1. Laetare Sunday is the Fourth Sunday of Lent each year.
2. Laetare is the Latin imperative translated as **Rejoice!**
3. Gaudete Sunday is observed on the Third Sunday of Advent.
4. Gaudete is the Latin imperative translated as **Be Joyful!**
5. Lent officially ends on Holy Thursday, just prior to the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper. That's when we enter the Sacred Triduum (three days of commemoration of the Lord's passion, death and resurrection).
