



Massawepie Trail Volunteers Needed

Who keeps the many miles of trails at Massawepie Scout Camps clear and open for Scouts to hike? Volunteers! And more volunteers are needed, especially in two areas:

1) Short-term: Boardwalk construction in a boggy area on Saturday, June 1 during Beaver Weekend. Primary tasks: carrying lumber and nailing boards. Housing and ample food provided. Opportunities to test your insect repellent effectiveness are likely, but so are the immediate rewards of seeing a well-traveled trail transformed!

2) Longer-term: Trail adopters, to maintain 1-3 miles of Massawepie trail on a regular basis. The adopter could be an individual, family or group. Visit the trail at least twice per year: once in May/June before camp opens to get it cleared and ready for summer, and again later (ideally in July) to prune back new growth. Hand tools needed; chain saw use not included unless an adopter is trained and approved. May include occasional paint blazing or larger trail projects as needed.
