There is an entrance fee to the park of \$20 per person or \$35 per vehicle.

Cell service at the Park is spotty and there is an entrance fee (see above); plan accordingly. Weather/travel issues/wildlife may cause modification of the schedule; we will have a communication plan for participants.
