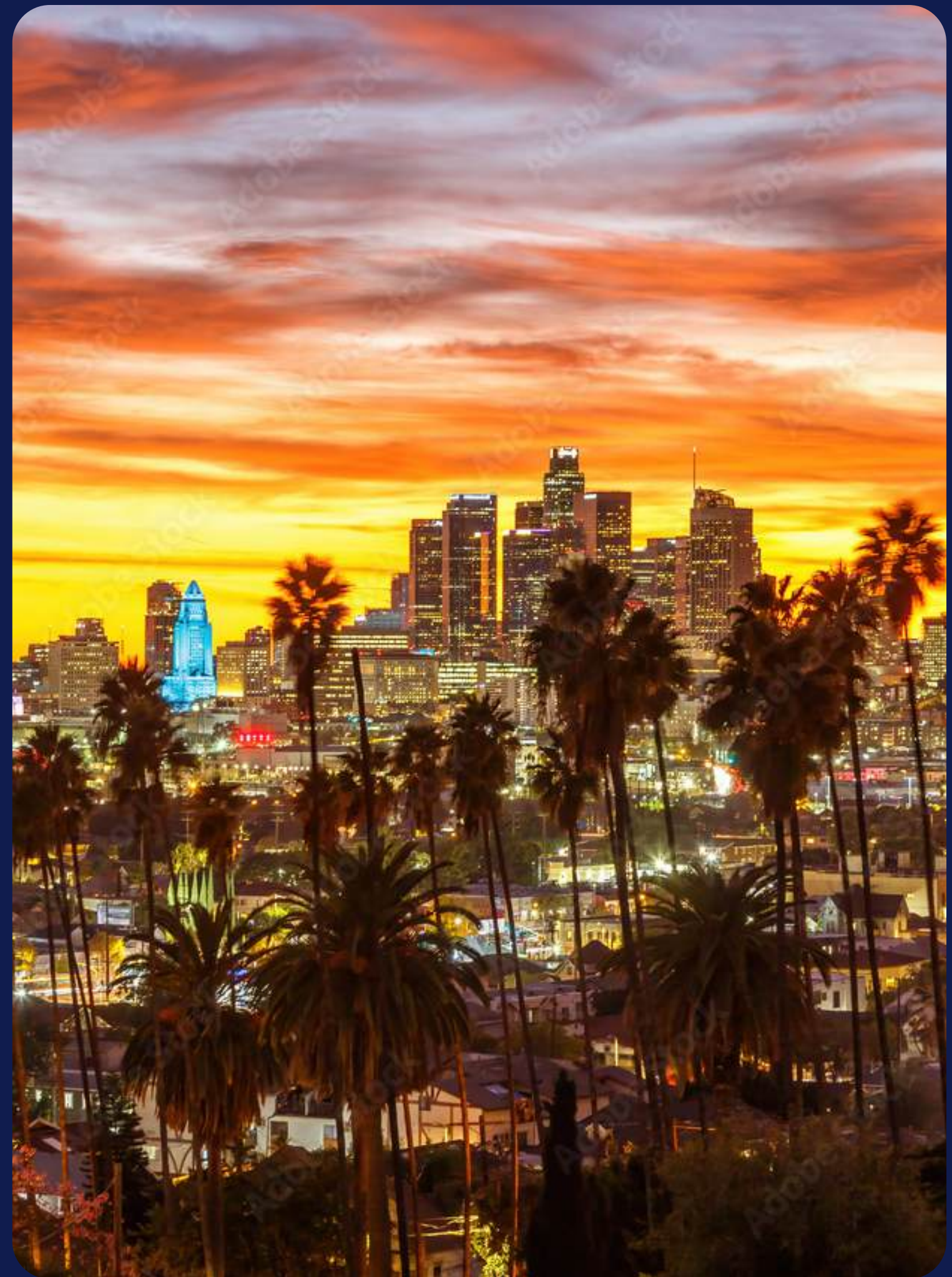

How Much Money Should Students Bring?

Money for Snacks & Souvenirs

Students should not bring a large amount of cash (balance controlled debit card is recommended)

Luggage Guidelines and How to Pack

There are many ways students could plan to pack all of their belongings needed for this trip.
These are just some suggestions.

Option 1

- Personal Item
(Backpack w/flute or clarinet inside)
- Large Carry-on
(clothes and NPMK garment bag inside)
- No checked bag \$0

Option 2

- Personal Item
(Backpack)
- Trumpet, Mello, Sax
as carry-on
- Checked Bag
(w/clothes and garment bag inside)
\$40

Option 3

- Personal Item
(Backpack)
- Large Carry-on
(clothes and NPMK garment bag inside)
- Large instrument
checked (trombone,
baritone) \$40

Luggage Guidelines and How to Pack

To reduce the amount of large instruments students must bring and keep luggage costs down, we are renting some instruments. This list is as of December 17 and could change - we will send updates when possible!

Luggage Guidelines and How to Pack

General Packing Guidelines:

- Your Photo ID – If you're over 18 you **must** have a RealID or a Passport
- Remember all suitcases, carry-on bags, personal items, and instrument cases will be subject to search by school security and TSA. Check TSA regulations [here](#)
- If it doesn't belong in school, it doesn't belong in your luggage!
- The average high temperature in LA in January is 67 degrees and the average low is 50 degrees. It does occasionally rain, though rare. Check the forecast for the week before packing.

For your Instrument:

- Anything you need to perform including
 - Extra reeds
 - Valve/slide oil
 - Music for Jazz Band

Luggage Guidelines and How to Pack

What to Pack for the NPMK Parade

- Traditional Uniform (including Guard) including all parts – Gauntlets, Citation Cord, Wristies, Gloves, Dinkles, etc.
 - Please contact Mr. Santanello directly if you are missing any parts
- Get it dry cleaned if necessary! Some of them are VERY wrinkled.

Other Packing Items

- Jazz Band students – all black outfit (long pants, short or long sleeved shirt) for performance
- Enough clothes for 6 days and 5 nights – make sure it is weather appropriate! Check forecast before packing! Remember – those are average temperatures!
- Socks, underwear, pajamas (remember you're sharing a bed)
- Reusable water bottle if you want (you can bring these into Disney if they are empty)
- Toiletries – DEODORANT, toothpaste, toothbrush, etc.
- Snacks – things to munch on in the hotel room at night, a few healthy snacks to carry around Disney or LA (granola bars, beef jerky, etc.)

For your Personal Item

- Anything you want for the plane (headphones, book, small pillow, etc.)
- Phone charger, cord, portable charging pack (really important – phones WILL die on these long days!)

Medications

- Health Form & photocopy of your insurance card required
- If your child is bringing medication, the name and amount to be taken must be written on the medical form
- Students may bring & self administer medications
- Medications must be in original container, accompanied by a parent note
- Bring only enough for the days on the trip
- Emergency medications must be carried with you at all times
- Medications and parent note should be in a plastic bag on top of the suitcase (for bag check)
- Students are permitted to bring tylenol or ibuprofen (parent note is required)
- Pack sunscreen and be prepared to use it.
- Bring inhalers/EpiPen or allergy medicine if you have allergies. Do Not pack in your checked bag. Must be packed in your personal item or carry-on bag.
- If your child has a food allergy, they must inform a nurse and contact Peak Group travel – bruce@peakgrouptravel.com

Hotel Rooms

- All students have been assigned a room at this time. Students had a window of opportunity to sign up for a room, then any students who did not sign up were assigned to a room. The period for adjustments has ended.
- Please check room assignments [here](#)
- Students are not permitted to leave their rooms after the designated room check time
- Chaperones/Staff will check student rooms each night and seal the door with tape
- Chaperones/Staff will open the door each morning
- Students are not allowed to leave the room for any reason outside of fire alarm
 - In the event of emergencies, students contact the front desk who will alert Mr. Santanello
 - **Leaving the room (breaking the tape seal on the door) is grounds for dismissal from the trip**
- Private security is on duty from 11 PM – 5 AM each day

Groups

- At various times throughout the trip students must stay with their assigned group
- Groups are based on hotel room assignments. Students are not allowed to change groups

- Students will be in a Group Chat with their Chaperone for all important information
- If you haven't joined the Band App yet, you must do it now (travelers ONLY)



Student Behavior

School Trips are an extension of school

- Students on the trip are subject to all North Penn School District rules and regulations as per the Student Code of Conduct
- Student behavior will be taken very seriously – you are representing North Penn and the Band Program as a whole
- ZERO tolerance for drugs (including tobacco/vapes), and alcohol
- Any violation will result in immediate dismissal from the trip
 - This means you will be sent home on the next available flight and subject to NPHS Discipline
- Student attendance/accountability is important – your chaperone/director MUST be able to reach you at all times
