(Donations \$1k, Concessions \$9k, KOS \$21k, Fundraising \$5k, Participation Fees \$6k)

## Expenses for October -\$ 43,794.25

(Concessions \$13k, KOS \$5k, Fundraising \$8k, Staff \$11k, Show expense \$3.5k, Meals \$2k, Participation expenses -\$2.5k (refund of guard unis), Peach bowl student credit \$2.7k)

- Concession ending profit around \$16,500 compared to budget of \$23,000.
- KOS \$13,200 net income. Budgeted at \$15,000.
  - Due to these budget deficits, additional fundraising will be needed to cover the Indoor Program.
    - Amazon Smile, Spring Trivia Night (4/14/23), Lock-in (Feb/March), Clothing Drive (May 2023) are future possibilities.
    - \$5000 was budgeted for Student Credit for Peach Bowl. The current Peach Bowl expense is \$9000. This will need to be covered by fundraisers also.
  - Audit Committee must be a voting member and not on the current Executive Board. Therefore the people on the committee are not all eligible. John will work with Recording Secretary to determine who this could be.
