UPDATES:

Hello everyone, thank you for taking the time to read my updates. There is a bit to talk about this time. I moved back to Lacken House and got to work with the operations team for a bit before the last bit of time with Immersion. The last month is pretty sad, with all the other students leaving while I stay here but I have to trust in God that I am where I am supposed to be.

There was a team from Johnson Ferry in Marietta Georgia here in June and it was nice to talk with people from my own state for a bit. They helped us replace the roofs on some of the chalets here. It was great having help with some of these bigger tasks and seeing how quickly it went by when we had a full team. I loved working with them, they were so encouraging to me and they cooked while they were here and I got to share in their meals, it made me a little homesick for food back home for a while.

Next we had kind of a mini outreach just a few days ago and we had people from all over come and help. We put on a VBS for them and I had to help design it, it was a little stressful being in charge of something like that but it was also kind of nice having that responsibility, it was something new so that was good. The team I went out with had me, 2 girls from Switzerland, and 2 guys from the Netherlands, we were at the Ballinasloe Christian Fellowship working with about 40 kids from around the area. It was really heartbreaking hearing some of the kids talk about how we were faking it telling them that Jesus loves them, it really showed me just

how much they need to hear the gospel here. Working with the kids was also a great experience and seeing them interact with us and saying the memory verses so they can get prizes was so cool to me. The team was so great to work with it was amazing how well we worked together even though we had never met each other before.

Now is one of the last days of the Immersion program and everyone is about to head back home or on vacation and it will be hard saying goodbye to everyone while I stay but I am looking forward to what God has planned for me in the year to come.

In a few days I leave for Germany for a thing called Teen Street and I will be a leader there. I'm a little nervous but also super excited to see all the teens from around Europe worshiping God.
