ABOUT THE LEAGUE

The League for People with Disabilities is committed to offering individuals the opportunity to gain independence, increase self-sufficiency and to improve their quality of life. The League has 95 years of history supporting individuals and families in Baltimore's disability community. The League provides services to more than 2,000 participants each year through the following programs:



ADULT MEDICAL DAY

The Adult Medical Day program serves individuals 18+ years, who have limited ability to independently perform activities such as eating, communicating, and personal hygiene. Participants are offered a wide array of therapeutic and recreational activities that increase mental acuity and physical ability, stimulate interest in life, nurture friendships and provide opportunities for creativity.



BEHAVIOR SUPPORT SERVICES

The Behavior Support Services program helps children and adults with autism and other development disabilities develop customized behavior plans within the home, community, and/or program settings, allowing them to better integrate with others in those environments.

DAY HARII ITATION

Day Habilitation provides safe, therapeutic, educational and meaningful activities for adults with disabilities who are looking for an introduction into the world of work. The League partners with other local organizations for volunteerism and pre-employment activities, educational opportunities, life skills and wellness, and sports and recreation.

CAMPING AND RECREATION SERVICES

Since its inception in 1937, Camp Greentop, located near Thurmont, Maryland, has been meeting the recreational needs of children and adults with disabilities. It is one of the oldest residential camps of its kind in the U.S. Camp Greentop provides joyful, life-changing experiences in a safe environment and builds meaningful relationships in the lives of youth and adults with disabilities. Camp staff also provide weekend respite services, as well as travel and winter camping opportunities.



CLUB 1111

CLUB1111 is the world's first and only inclusive adult nightclub catering to individuals with disabilities. On the second Saturday of each month, year-round, The League's facility is transformed into a nightclub complete with DJs, two dance floors, a spa, games, mocktail lounge and much more.

LEAGUE INDUSTRIES

League Industries is a full-service printing, mailing and courier service. It provides integrated employment for skilled individuals with and without disabilities.

ABOUT THE LEAGUE

MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS (MS) DAY

The MS Day program is designed to help individuals with Multiple Sclerosis achieve their highest possible level of independence and quality of life. Programming includes independent living skills, therapeutic group interaction, social and recreational opportunities, and physical and occupational therapy.



PERSONAL SUPPORT SERVICES

Personal Support Services assist children and adults with disabilities to become more independent, self-sufficient, and active in their community. Housekeeping, cooking/preparing meals, budgeting, interactions with others, and engaging in fun and meaningful activities are just some of the areas of focus in this program. Through one-to-one support, participants are able to discover their passions, access social and recreational opportunities, and enjoy the world around them.



SCALE APHASIA PROGRAM

Aphasia is a condition that can affect your ability to speak, write and understand language, both verbal and written. Aphasia typically occurs suddenly after a stroke or a head injury. The Snyder Center for Aphasia Life Enhancement (SCALE) program improves the quality of life for people living with aphasia and their families, providing a place to socially connect, participate in interactive group activities such as art and gardening, have access to education and training opportunities, and get involved with advocacy projects.

WELLNESS CENTER

The Emmert Hobbs Fitness Center and the Malcolm Hecht Therapeutic Pool offer a variety of memberships, classes and services that are open to the community, regardless of ability.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

The Workforce Development program provides training and employment services for youth and adults with disabilities to help each individual discover talents, develop skills, and become productive members of the workforce. The League works with employers to meet their hiring needs and diversify their workforce by connecting them with qualified, pre-screened candidates.

YOUTH AUTISM SERVICES

This program provides home and community-based instructional services for children with autism spectrum disorder. The community-based service is offered at The League from 3-6 PM on school days, where children participate in activities such as music and movement exercises, arts and crafts, and more. The home-based service functions in individuals' homes, providing support, family consultation, and ensuring the plan for the child with autism is consistent throughout school, in the home and programs in which they participate.
