

## **Reflections at the Celtic Service.**

One of the ways that the Celtic Service will be different from our normal Sunday morning services is that the sermon will actually be a reflection that is normally offered by lay people!

Everyone is invited to prayerfully consider whether they would like to share how God is present in their life. But first, it would probably be good for you to “come and see” a couple services first so you can get a feel for what a reflection looks like, sounds like, what it communicates, and what it isn’t intended to communicate.

We will provide a means to sign up to offer reflections later this year. Should you discern that you have a “God moment” from your life that you would like to share, you would simply sign up through the offered means. Once you are signed up, you will be contacted to discuss any parameters and address any questions you may have.

Here is a short explanation of the Reflection:

- it is very brief, 3-5 minutes, no longer
- it is intended to be personal - telling us about your experience of God
- it is NOT intended to tell us about God, rather it is your encounter with God in real life
- Because it is so short and only focused on one experience we hope you will be open to sharing again
- The goal is to share an understanding of how you encounter God and how God works in your life.

Next month we will let you know how you may sign up to offer your own reflection. In the meantime, we invite you to “Come and See,” come to the Celtic Service at 5pm on Sundays to worship and to hear the reflections that are offered this coming month!
