

St. Philip's is re-organizing our Lay Eucharistic Visitors.

According to Canon III.4.7 of The Episcopal Church, Eucharistic Visitor is a lay person authorized to take the Consecrated Elements (Communion) in a timely manner following a Celebration of Holy Eucharist to members of the congregation who, by reason of illness or infirmity, were unable to be present at the Celebration.

To be a Lay Eucharistic Visitor, you must be trained by the priests of your parish and licensed by the Diocese of East Carolina.

If you were a Lay Eucharistic Visitor before COVID, your license was renewed.
