

## Bible and Breakfast

Beginning Thursday, April 21, Canon Jim Hanisian will offer a Bible Study for anyone at St. Philip's. We will begin at 7:30 a.m. and end promptly at 9. It will be conducted over Zoom, so grab a cup of coffee, a Bible and log in.

The purpose of our study will be to see how the Biblical story relates to our story and how the words we read can help us to explore and deepen our faith in Jesus Christ. The class will meet weekly throughout the year and is suitable for the beginner as well as those who have done Bible Study before.

The first book we will consider is The First Letter of Paul to the Corinthians. It is one of the earliest writings of the New Testament and in it St. Paul speaks to issues that are alive for Christians today. We will take our time reading and discussing what we have read. Since we will be going slowly, it is okay if you have to miss a session. We won't get too far before you can return. All you need is a Bible and a willingness to share from your own experiences.
