CLEANING AND DISINFECTING INSTRUCTIONS

CLEANING

For the oak part of the pews, we recommend you use 'Guardman Wood Scent' polish. This is an excellent product and can usually be obtained at any good furniture store. Shake well, use a soft damp cloth, add some Guardsman to it and go over the wood. Then wipe dry with another soft cloth. This acts as both a cleaning and polishing agent.

We suggest that you stay away from products such as 'Pledge' or other spray polishes as they usually have a silicone or plastic base. If you at some point want to refinish the pews, this kind of wood treatment is very hard if not impossible to completely remove and that could adversely affect the way new finish would adhere to the existing finish. The 'Guardman' polish will not cause you a problem in refinishing.

DISINFECTING

Step 1

Fill a spray bottle with 2 cups water, 1 cup white vinegar, and about five drops dish soap if the wood is soiled. The vinegar disinfects, and the dish soap works as an added cleaning element.

Step 2

Spray the solution onto the wood furniture and wipe off with a damp cleaning rag. Using a damp rag removes traces of the vinegar and soap. Continue across the wood furniture until the piece is cleaned and disinfected.

Step 3

Wipe the furniture with a dry clean rag to remove any excess moisture, and use this solution as your all-purpose wood cleaner and disinfectant.
