Naviance is a comprehensive college and career readiness that helps connect academic achievement to post-secondary goals. Family Connection is a customizable planning portal for students and families that helps students assess their strengths, interests and learning styles, set long-term goals, create multi-year academic course plans, explore career options, and plan for college. This tool is particularly important senior year because students will use it to create their official college list, request letters of recommendation, track college acceptances, and more.

New Users - How to Register:

- Go to <https://connection.naviance.com/energyihs>
- Click "I need to register" on the right side of the screen.
- When prompted enter the registration code you were given.
- You will be prompted to enter information. You will enter your personal email address two times and then create a password. Make sure you use a password you are familiar with and won't forget or that you store it in a safe place.
