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CanREACH Application

Bow Valley PCN has prioritized a grant received via the Calgary Zone PCN Mental Health Task Force to reimburse registration fees for up to 12 PCN MD members to participate in the CanREACH training program. Funding has been extended to include three courses in 2022 and is available for up to 3 additional Bow Valley PCN primary care providers.

CanREACH is an accredited, patient-centered mental health in pediatric primary care program, adapted for Canadian Primary Care Providers. The goal is to support management of pediatric mental health needs in primary care. CanREACH is currently delivered virtually and consists of two components:

1. A workshop - a dynamic, interactive 2 day (15 hour) course using intensive face-to-face teachings and hands-on practice. Topics include assessing/treating anxiety, depression, ADHD, aggression and more.
2. 3-6 months of case-based calls – an ongoing case-based program where participants are divided into smaller groups. Participants meet to apply weekend learnings to real patient cases in their practice.

The May 13-14, 2022 session is fully subscribed. There is one remaining CanREACH training program in 2022. Bow Valley PCN has been able to hold up to 3 spots in this condensed course. Here are the details:

- September 9-10, 2022 (followed by 3 months of weekly case consultations from Sep 13 - Nov 29)

Bow Valley PCN Physician members are invited to apply to have the \$800 registration fee reimbursed by the PCN following completion of the weekend course.
