THE VISION BEHIND THIS YEAR'S OUTLOOK

1975 was a pivotal time for Southern Nevada. At the time Clark County only had **350,000** residents but we were rapidly expanding with new entertainment and hospitality venues. Total student attendance at University of Nevada, Las Vegas that year was **7,810**.

Fast forward to 2025, and we find ourselves in a similar situation, except we are now in the **top 30** largest metropolitan areas in the country with average yearly visitor attendance on par with Paris, and we are home to several successful professional sports teams. UNLV's attendance has grown to over **33,000 students**, we've won national titles in several major NCAA tournaments. Today, the university is designated as an R1 institution, the highest ranking given by the Carnegie Classification of Institutions, meaning we are in the top quartile of applied public economic research centers in the country by research funding and number of staff.

Nevada has a unique economic history, where two dominant industries have shaped our past while sometimes contributing to a boom-and-bust cycle. But Nevada, and our urban communities, are not isolated archipelagoes in a sea of desert. We share a **610-mile border** with the fifth-largest economy in the world, and in an era of unprecedented change, global connections and emerging challenges—whether from artificial intelligence, climate change, tariffs, consumer demand, or economic shifts—are shaping our future in ways we are only beginning to understand.

CBER's economic research continues to focus on:

- **Growth & Demographics:** Nevada's population is set to hit 4 million by 2042, with a younger population than the national average.
- **Diversification & Opportunity:** Nevada remains the entertainment capital of the world, it has also become a hub for professional sports, technology, and battery manufacturing.
- **Economic Resilience:** We've survived a pandemic, adapted to global economic shifts, tariffs, and continue to prepare for the next transformation of the US and global economy.
