



ACEC-NH “2019 PINS for PAC”

Event Rules

May 16, 2019

1. Each lane shall have a “team” comprised of 4 players. All scores on the team will be used to determine the team average for scoring purposes. No teams under 4 players will be eligible for the Championship Title. In the event that the winning team is split with players from two different ACEC-member firms, the Championship Title will be awarded in the name of both firms.
2. All bowlers must register their names on the electronic scoring pad at their respective lanes.
3. Each team will bowl two (2) strings. The first string will be a “warm-up/practice” game but scores **MUST** be posted because they will be used to break any ties. The second string is the official “Scoring” game.
4. The average score for all the playing members on the team in the second string (scoring round) will be tabulated. The highest average team score will be declared the “2019 Champions”. In the event of a tie, the highest average team score in the “warm-up” round will determine the Championship Title. In the unlikely event there is still a tie after averages are tabulated for both strings, the team with the highest individual score in the “scoring round” will determine the final team winner.
5. Besides the “2019 PINS for PAC Championship” trophy, awards will be made for the highest individual score and lowest team score of the tournament.
6. The ACEC-NH 2019 PINS for PAC Event Committee reserves the right to be the sole arbiter and interpreter of all rules relating to the 2019 PINS for PAC Championship Event.
