Cardiology Compendium

The MaineHealth Cardiology Physicians workgroup, a subcommittee of SeHR Physicians for Clinical Informatics group, has completed their review of all available Cardiology documentation. This final product is the implementation of several new SmartTexts moved to Epic Production on Sept. 18. All SmartTexts begin with the standard naming convention of “MH IP CAR.” *See the Cardiology Compendium tip sheet.*

Nephrology Overview

A new overview report has been created and moved into Production named “Overview - Nephrology.” Although designed specifically for the nephrologists, others may find this report useful, as well.

SeHR Tips:

Did you know that you can click on the:

- **Attending** Physician in the patient header to view the Treatment Team Assignments?
- **Code** order in the patient header to view the actual order, code status history and advance care planning documents?
- **Active FYIs** to see the entire list of patient’s FYIs?

Are you using the search feature within the patient’s record? Once you have clicked into the patient’s record, the search field in the upper right-hand corner allows you to quickly search for information across all patient encounters including:

- Notes
- Labs
- Medications
- Imaging
- Procedures
- Orders
- Allergies
- Immunizations
- Problems

The Index Report has been removed as the default report. If you are having trouble finding your treatment team sticky notes or orders to co-sign, you can add the report to the toolbar in the **Summary Activity**. *See how to add your index report.*
