 Mystery Block Quilt-A-Long
 Paper Pinwheels

Finished Block Size 12"

Cutting Instructions:



(A) Medium - (1) 6 1/2" square



(B) Medium - (2) 4" squares, cut once on the diagonal



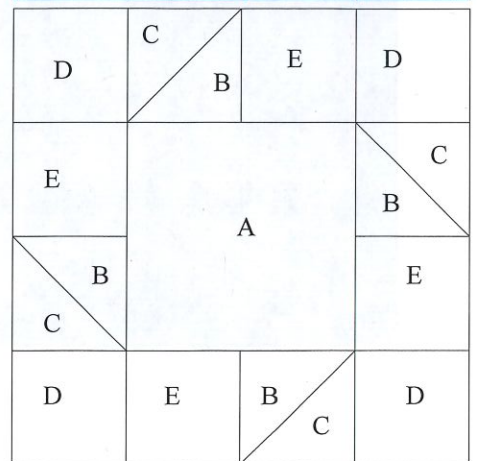
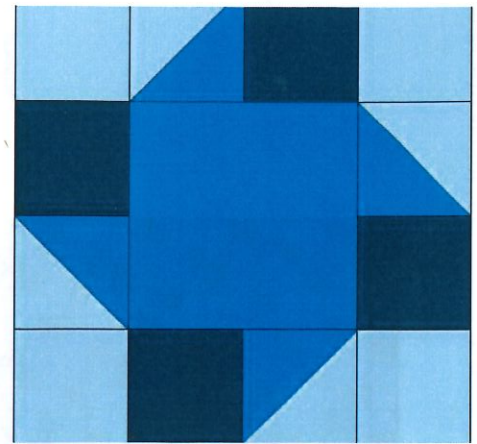
(C) Light - (2) 4" squares, cut once on the diagonal



(D) Light - (4) 3 1/2" squares



(E) Dark - (4) 3 1/2" squares



Assembly:

1. Make four half-square triangle (HST) units by sewing your four medium (B) triangles and four light (C) triangles along the long side.
2. Set your seams, and press toward the dark side. Press gently and carefully to avoid stretching your bias edges.
3. Square your half-square triangle units to 3 1/2".
4. Lay out your units according to the picture, making sure your half-square triangle units are orientated the correct direction.
5. Sew your HST's to your dark (E) squares. Set your seams and press toward (E).
6. Sew your light (D) squares to each side of two of your HST and E units. Press toward (D).
7. Sew you remaining two HST and E units to the (A), center square. Press toward (A)
8. Sew your rows together. Because you pressed your seams in opposite directions, they should nest.
 1. Set your seams, and press them either to the center of the block or open.
 2. Square unfinished block to 12 1/2".
