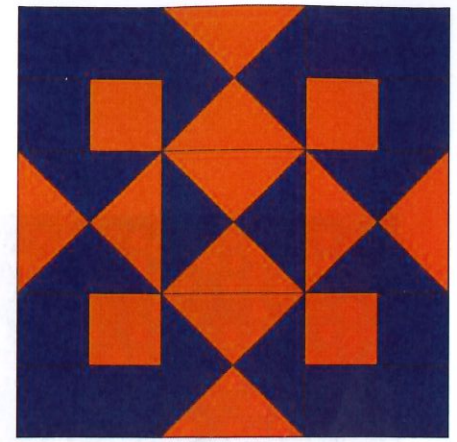

# Mystery Block Quilt-A-Long

## Four Corners

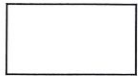


Finished Block Size 12"

Cutting Instructions:



(A) Dark - (3) 5 1/2" square, cut twice on the diagonal  
(for hourglass units)



(B) Dark - (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles



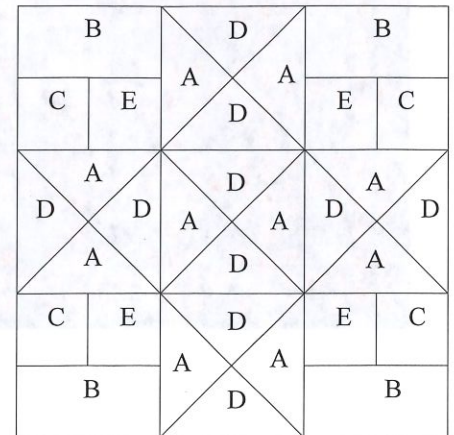
(C) Dark - (4) 2 1/2" squares



(D) Light - (3) 5 1/2" square, cut twice on the diagonal  
(for hourglass units)



(E) Light - (4) 2 1/2" squares



Assembly:

1. Gather your twelve dark (A) and twelve light (D) triangles. Sew right short sides of your (A) triangles to the left short sides of your (D) triangles. Set your seam, and press toward the dark, being careful not to stretch the bias edges. Each of these units will be half of your hourglass unit.
2. Assemble your hourglass units by placing your two halves right sides together, nesting your seams. Set your seams, and press open.
3. Square your hourglass units to 4 1/2". You only need five hourglass units for this block, however we suggest to piece them all and choose the best five for your block. The extra unit could be used as a label on the back of your finished quilt.
4. Sew your dark (C) squares to your light (E) squares. Set your seams, and press toward the dark.
5. Lay out your block according to the diagram, ensuring your hourglass units are orientated the correct way, as well as your (C) and (E) units.
6. Stitch your (C) and (E) units to your dark (B) rectangle. Set your seam and press toward the rectangle.
7. Sew your units into rows. Set your seams, and press open.
8. Sew your rows together. Set your seams, and press open.
9. Square your block to 12 1/2".
