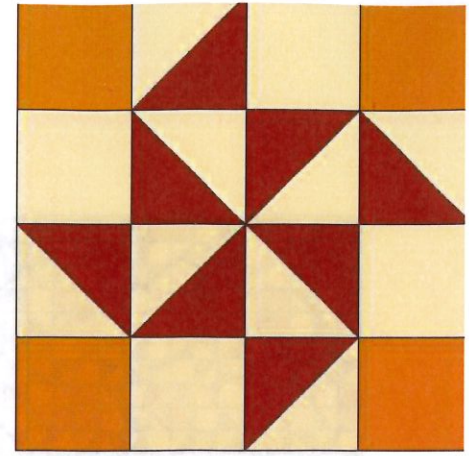




## November 2021 Mystery Block Quilt-A-Long X Quartet



Finished Block Size 12"

Cutting Instructions:



(A) Light - (4) 4" squares, cut once on the diagonal



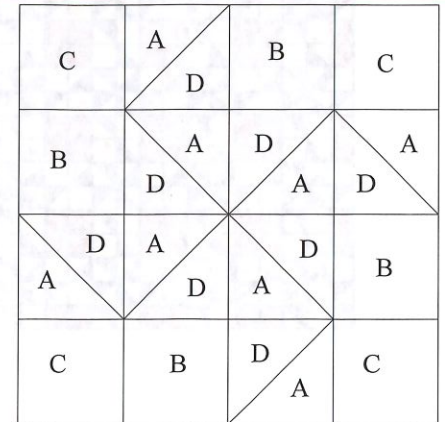
(B) Light - (4) 3 1/2" squares



(C) Medium - (4) 3 1/2" squares



(D) Dark - (4) 4" squares, cut once on the diagonal



### Assembly:

1. Make eight half-square triangle (HST) units by sewing your eight light (A) triangles and eight dark (D) triangles along the long side.
2. Set your seams, and press toward the dark side. Press gently and carefully to avoid stretching your bias edges.
3. Square your half-square triangle units to 3 1/2".
4. Lay out your units according to the picture, making sure your half-square triangle units are orientated the correct direction.
5. Sew your units into rows. Rows one and three will have the seams pressed to the right. Rows two and four, press seams to the left.
6. Sew your rows together. Because you pressed your seams in opposite directions, they should nest.
7. Set your seams, and press them open to reduce bulk.
8. Square unfinished block to 12 1/2".
