Suicide has increased 44.8% from 1,268 to 1,836


"We are currently finalizing a state plan for suicide prevention that aims to reduce suicides in Ohio by 20%.

Ohioans die by suicide every day




In 2018, 78.9% (1,449) of all suicides were males
