The Garage Mahal, Chefs Table and HGTV Designer Featured at the Downtown Cleveland 2020 NARI Home Improvement Show

Induction cooking in an interactive kitchen with a **Chef’s Table** where local restaurants will be featured is all part of a working display created by Ken Perrin of Artistic Renovations of Ohio. The idea is to allow attendees to see the latest in kitchen appliances so they can integrate the features into their own homes.

“When you watch a professional chef working on an induction cooktop you’ll see the versatility and efficiency immediately,” said Perrin.

The 2020 NARI Home Improvement Show will also be bringing in celebrity **Alison Victoria, as seen on HGTV’s Kitchen Crashers, Windy City Rehab and Rock the Block.** She appears on the Main Stage Saturday, January 11th at 12 noon and 2:00 pm. Alison will also at Celebrity Sponsor booths Ohio State Waterproofing and Remodel Me Today immediately following her respective stage appearances.

In the continuing effort to get more young people involved in the trades, students from the Polaris and Medina County Career Centers will be displaying custom made mailboxes all of which will be raffled off to raise money for the **Cleveland Animal Protective League**, who will also be at the show with their mobile pet adoption unit. Over 3,000 square foot of the show floor will feature **The Hot Tub and Swim Spa Pavilion** showcasing the latest technology in performance, luxury and quality.
