Financial 'stuff'

The full cost of Botswana!2020 is USD \$8350.00 (**all dollars quoted are USD**) payable according to the schedule below.

Until the trip is fully paid, costs are subject to change at any time due to fluctuations in fuel costs, taxes, levies, Government regulations, exchange rates and factors imposed on suppliers that are beyond our control.

Cost is based on double occupancy. Please let [me](#) know as soon as you can if you wish single occupancy, so I can find out if it's available.

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$1650.00 due upon registration.

2nd Payment: \$1700.00 due June 15, 2019

Balance: Balance of \$5000.00 before February 14, 2020. If sending cheques, please allow 10 days for Canadian snail mail and banking delays.

Should you pay in any other currency you'll be credited with the bank or Paypal's USD equivalent on that day, and any adjustment can be settled on a later invoice.

Cost includes (with all taxes):

- All flights within Africa: Johannesburg - Maun - Johannesburg and air transfers between camps. If you think you may want to go on to Chobe or Victoria Falls from Setari I will hold off buying the ticket back to Johannesburg.
- Transport including tips to and from all airports/runways.
- All accommodation B&B in Johannesburg/Pilanesberg. June 21,22,23,24,25 and July 4.
- All accommodation, meals, and beverages in Moremi, Camp Kalahari and Setari Camp.
- Group dinners in Johannesburg June 23 and July 4.

Cost does not include:

- Airfare between your home and Johannesburg.
- Travel and medical insurance. The cost is non-refundable, so please insure it! (your local travel agent or airline will be able to advise you on this, or I can let you know what others have chosen on previous trips)
- Visas – I will provide more information later, since regulations for Botswana are in flux,.
- Additional nights/meals in Johannesburg, which can be arranged, as can transportation for sight-seeing, shopping, balloon rides or anything else you may choose to do.
- Food in Johannesburg other than all breakfasts, and group dinners.

There are always questions about how much money one should bring for tips and predictable incidentals. I will be providing more of this information closer to the trip.
