County

Allegheny County Health Department's new Vaccine Registration site is now open to the public. Individuals seeking vaccine appointments may register online at <http://vax4.alleghenycounty.us> for available events. Visitors to the site will have four options to choose from: schedule first dose, schedule second dose, reschedule appointment, and cancel appointment. If choosing "schedule first dose," the user will answer four questions, three of which are used to gauge whether they are eligible for vaccination before completing health screening questions. If the user is currently eligible for vaccination, and appointments are available, the next step will be to select an appointment. Individuals who are not eligible yet, or for whom appointments are not available, will be invited to pre-register. Users who have pre-registered will be notified via email or text, as selected by them, when they are eligible for vaccination and appointments are available. Individuals who are pre-registered will be given priority to schedule an appointment for 48 hours before remaining appointments will be opened to the general public.

If don't have internet access or have difficulty navigating the online registration system, can call 2-1-1 daily from 9:00-noon to schedule at one of the county's vaccine sites (including Ross Township Community Center). Select option 1 for covid related, then select option 1 again for 1st vaccine.

For Pennsylvania senior citizens only, Rite-Aid has launched COVID scheduling at 568 Caste Village Rd in Pittsburgh (Whitehall). Call 1-866-674-4659 and go through the prompts x2 x1 x1 x1. This service is for next-day scheduling only. Must have an email or cell phone number to register (can use one from a family member or trusted friend).

Walmart

Walmart is hosting several clinics across the state, including Cranberry Township. Call 1-800-753-8827 from 8 AM to 5 PM Monday-Friday. Actual appointment dates/times unknown. You may have trouble getting through and could be on hold for a while.
