

Harvey Tesch Memorial Fund helps build Fresh Water Wells in the Congo

The Outreach Committee has sent a check to UMCOR in the amount of \$2,848.88 to be used to build fresh water wells in the Congo. This is a project that was close to the heart of Harvey Tesch and the money comes from his memorial fund. Monies in the memorial fund are from donations and from the breakfast sandwich fundraiser held by the Outreach Committee.

The water available to the villages in the Congo for drinking and cooking is either polluted or stagnant. Disease is rampant and many die. There are often outbreaks that decimate entire villages. Not only is physical health a problem but intellectual health is as well. The children are often too sick to attend school. Clean water is critical to meet the health and basic human needs of these people.

Reaching out to help God's people locally, nationally and internationally is the role of Sandy Mount's Outreach Committee. Thank you for your support.

Greeters: Do you have a gift of welcoming others? Consider being a greeter needed for both services each week. Pass out bulletins, provide guidance to visitors, answer questions about ministries and happenings at SMUMC.

In-Between Cafe: Perhaps you have enjoyed sharing a snack and a coffee with your church family. Consider sponsoring an In-Between Cafe. Provide light refreshments for a specific Sunday, or become a regular! Assistance is available to get out paper and plasticware - coffee is made by our resident experts!


