

Pork Belly Ventures has chosen to provide RideWithGPS (RWGPS) routes for RAGBRAI LIII.

If you have a bike computer (Wahoo or Garmin for example):

- This will allow you to pin routes and have them appear on your bike computer.

If you prefer to navigate by phone:

- This will let you download the route to your phone and receive turn-by-turn navigation from campsite to campsite with no need for cell signal.

1) **RWGPS Account:** go to [RWGPS](#) and create a free account.

2) **App:** download RWGPS app from [App Store](#) or [Google Play Store](#)

3) **Join account:** [join MyBikeNav Tour Operator account as a member](#).

This allows you to download routes and get turn by turn directions.

4) **Join event(s)** you are participating in. [PBV RAGBRAI LIII](#) or [Gravel](#)

Groups of routes are organized into events. Click event link → RSVP

Your RSVP will allow for you to be notified should the routes change.

- o [PBV RAGBRAI LIII](#): Consists of 9 routes (three for day five: regular, Karras century, and 250K). These routes go from PBV campsite to PBV campsite.
- o [PBV Gravel RAGBRAI LIII](#): 7 routes, with all the gravel segments.

5) **Saving Routes:** pin (for cyclecomputer) and/or download (for phone) your routes.

- Download: On the event page on your phone, you can choose to download routes. This will store all the routes in that event onto your phone, for offline use.

Click the three dots in the upper right; click those, then Download Routes.

- o To download individual routes, click the three dots by the route instead.
- Pin: click the three dots next to each day's route, then choose pin.
- If navigating by phone, you're ready for the ride.
- If using a cyclecomputer connected with RWGPS, sync to your device:
 - o For Wahoo, that's via the Sync function on the Routes page.
 - o For Garmin, **Sync Your Device:** Open the **Garmin Connect** app on your phone and perform a manual sync.
- Highly recommend performing the above steps at home, not at RAGBRAI.
Limited cell signal in RAGBRAI towns can make it impossible to do the day of.



Download RWGPS App

Day of Event:

- If navigating on your phone, go to your route library on the RWGPS app, choose Offline, sort for location, choose nearby, and see today's route should rise to the top.
- On Wahoo, go to routes, sort by proximity, and today's route should appear.
- On Garmin, go to **Navigation > Courses > Saved Courses** and select your route.
