Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Greetings to you in the name of God's beloved Son, Who came to give His life for us.

I am writing to you as we face a very significant decision on March 26. At our Voters Meeting at Noon in the gym, we will vote on a proposal to fund the implementation of a capital campaign in the fall and to obtain enhanced building design plans for possible Phase 2 of Tell the Next Generation (TTNG) construction. I want to emphasize that we are not voting on March 26 to build anything and will not do so until we know how much we will expect to receive in pledged offerings. That vote, to proceed with construction, will probably take place in November, following the receiving of all pledges.

I cannot overemphasize how much God has blessed us following Phase 1 of TTNG. Thanks to Pastor Wade's, Principal Walker's, and Renee Hemmy's research, we have the following numeric summary of those blessings:


I must address the estimated cost range of \$17-22 million for Phase 2 of TTNG. Please know that we are working to reduce this cost in ways that will not compromise future ministry. Unfortunately, we are "land-locked" and we cannot expand outward without losing unacceptable amounts of parking space. So, the three-story design is placed before you with the realization that this will be our final chance for many years to come to increase and improve our ministry space on our North Campus.
