SITE TOUR! SEE THE SACRAMENTO REGIONAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

TOPIC:

Please join the SAME Sacramento Post for a field tour of the Sacramento Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant for a behind-the-scenes look at how the Sacramento Sewer District is working every day to protect public health and the environment by collecting, treating, and recovering resources from sewage – responsibly and cost-effectively. This plant provides wastewater conveyance and treatment services to more than 1.4 million residents in the Sacramento region, including the cities of Sacramento, Citrus Heights, Elk Grove, Folsom, Rancho Cordova, West Sacramento, and unincorporated Sacramento County. Wastewater travels through 177 miles of interceptors – large pipes, some big enough to drive a car through – to



the Sacramento Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant near Elk Grove. 136 million gallons of wastewater are treated each day and safely discharged into the Sacramento River. Learn more about one of the largest public works projects in the Sacramento region's history that takes wastewater treatment to a whole new level!

In this role, he is in charge of operations, maintenance, engineering, construction programs, and laboratory services at the EchoWater Resource Recovery Facility. During this time, he worked in a lead role for construction coordination, operator training development, asset management, and special studies. In August 2010, he was promoted to the Operations and Maintenance Manager. Bielefelt holds a Bachelor of Mechanical Engineering and a Master of Civil Engineering from California State University,

Sacramento. He has been a licensed Civil Engineer since 1998.
