TOPIC:

Join us for one of the largest Sacramento Area student scholarship award programs. **Colonel James J Handura**, commander of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Sacramento District, will provide this year's keynote address to the student scholarship recipients. **Over \$30,000 will be distributed to local high school and college students.**

SPEAKER:

Colonel James J. Handura assumed command of the Sacramento District in July 2019. He commands an organization of 1,100 engineers, scientists and support staff working in all or parts of eight western states. The Sacramento District is responsible for military design and construction, civil works, international and interagency support, real estate services to the Army and Air Force, regulatory work, environmental services, and emergency management.

Col. Handura began his military service with the United States Navy Seabee Reserves, serving as an Utilitiesman from 1987 to 1989, at Bayboro Harbor, St Petersburg, Florida. From 1989 to 1993, he served in the U.S. Army as an enlisted Combat Engineer, with the 82nd Engineer Battalion (Federal Republic of Germany) and the 20th Engineer Battalion (Ft. Campbell, Kentucky and later Ft. Hood, Texas).

Col. Handura's civilian education includes a Bachelor of Science in Geology from Austin Peay State University, a Master of Science in Geology and Geophysics from the University of Missouri-Rolla, a Master's Degree in Military Art and Science from the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College, and a Master's Degree in Strategic Studies from the U.S. Army War College. Col. Handura's many military awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal.
