A reception will be held for artists, friends & family, and the community to enjoy the artwork. All participants will receive recognition, and prizes will be awarded in three age categories: 6-8, 9-12, and 13-18, as well as a People's Choice Award.

Delta Township District Library's Art Show Guidelines

- Both 2D and 3D art will be accepted, including paintings (any medium), drawings, pastels, graphics, sculpture, pottery, and mixed media.
- All artwork must be the original creation of the artist. Each artist may submit only one piece of art.
- 3D art must be able to fit in our display cases; items may be no larger than 37" tall, 35" wide, and 9" deep.
- 2D art does not need to be framed, however it is encouraged (so it may be more easily hung for display—frames with hanging wire on the back are preferred). Canvas is also acceptable. Artwork may be adapted by staff for display purposes.
- Content of the artwork must be suitable for all ages.
- Art may be submitted to the library's Youth Desk (along with the entry form below) starting June 10. The deadline to enter is July 8.
- All artists are encouraged to attend the Art Show Reception on August 8 and are welcome to invite friends and family. Refreshments will be provided, ribbons will be given to all participants, and awards will be presented.
- Artwork will be reviewed by a panel of judges and prizes will be awarded to the first and second place artists in three age divisions, 6-8, 9-12, and 13-18.
- A People's Choice Award will also be presented. The community may vote for their favorite pieces any time during the exhibition (July 11–August 7); ballots will be available at the Youth Desk. (Please only one ballot per person.)
- Artists may take their artwork home after the reception or pick up their art at the Youth Desk the following week (August 9-17).
