

How to Dispose of Medication & Sharps in San Benito County

Mail-Back Envelopes

- Free at **all local pharmacies**
- Also available for free at **San Benito County Public Health Services**
 - 351 Tres Pinos Road, A-202 Hollister, CA 95023
 - Monday – Friday 8 am – 5 pm



Simply fill them with unused, unwanted, or expired medications, seal the envelope, drop off at your local USPS mailbox (shipping is already paid for).

Sharps Disposal Kiosks

 - Monday, Wednesday, Friday 9 am to 5 pm
- **San Benito Sheriff's Office**
 - 2301 Technology Pkwy, Hollister, CA 95023
 - Monday to Friday 8 am – 5 pm

Used sharps must be in an approved sharps container to dispose of at these locations.

Loose sharps will not be accepted as they pose a risk to individuals disposing of their sharps containers and those servicing the kiosks.

When disposing of your sharps containers at the San Benito Sheriff's Office please ensure you place them in the sharps kiosk and not the medication disposal kiosk.

 - Max 15 gallons or 125 lbs.
 - Proof of residency required
