Update on SafetySync Training

ICS 100 will be mandatory in your SafetySync portal effective June 30, 2017 and will affect your overall compliance.

Please remember to upload your certificate by this date so your overall compliance will not be affected.

Also, as of June 30, 2017, ERAC will start tracking the fall prevention training for all our responders. Fall prevention will be enabled as a mandatory certificate requirement. You will have two options in order to meet this new certificate requirement. You can upload your employer provided Fall Prevention Training Certificate or alternatively ERAC will enable Fall Prevention in your Online Courses as an Optional requirement on ERAC's LMS, SafetySync. If you take the course through SafetySync your certificate will automatically upload and mark you as compliant.



A reminder bulletin will be sent at the end of June once ICS 100 and Fall Prevention Training are enabled. As a reminder, to upload a training certificate to SafetySync please log into SafetySync (www.safetysync.com) and click on Training (*left hand side of your screen*), then click Certificate Tracking. Click on the certificate, then click on 'Attach New Certificate to upload to SafetySync'. Enter all the necessary details then click on 'Browse Computer' and select the file. The final step is to click 'save' at which point it is uploaded to the system.
