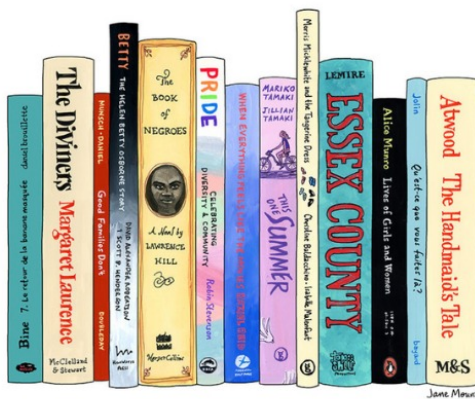

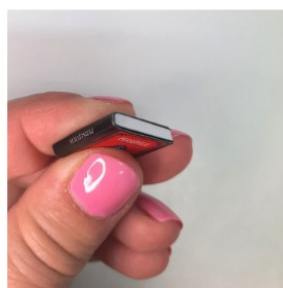

## Banned and Challenged Book Keychains



1. Gather your supplies



2. Fold the cover onto the book



3. Cover the outside of the book with Mod Podge



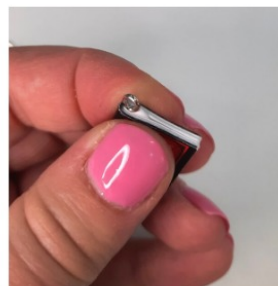
4. Carefully lay the cover in place and press firmly



5. Remove some pages from inside to make a gap



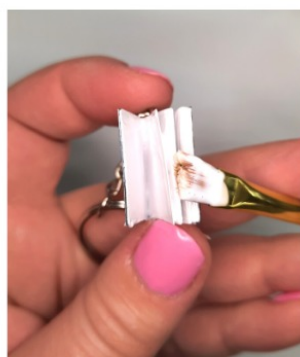
6. Fill the space and the pages with Mod Podge then lay the eye screw inside against the spine



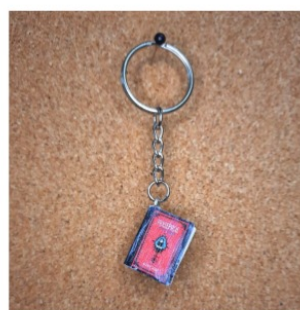
7. Press firmly then let dry



8. Join the eye screw to the key chain with a jump ring and close with pliers



9. Spread Mod Podge over the whole book, including between some pages. Don't worry, the streaks will disappear!



10. Hang to dry. If the book doesn't feel sturdy, apply a second layer.

11. Enjoy your new keychain! (Keep in mind that paper won't last forever as a keychain, but adding more Mod Podge might help if it starts to wear!)
