

On April 22, Earth Day, the Royal Saskatchewan Museum will be opening a new exhibit called "Home: Life in the Anthropocene". The exhibit looks at how humans have impacted the world in the last century, what we can do to lessen the impact and how beneficial it is to reconnect with nature.
